We suddenly have entered a new era that has severed our connections with the past. We are witnessing two temporal “revolutions” that have followed one after the other: first a very strong, tremendous acceleration that has exponentially increased the speed of social interactions; and now an unpredictable reduction in physical proximity and body contact due to the CoViD-19 pandemic.

Pandemic stress, due to a state of enduring stress and an unconventional mix of stress that not only affects the present but disrupts the future, is an entirely new condition that is becoming known to us in clinical practice.

Psychotherapy, and especially Body oriented ones, in this moment, is faced with a great challenge: on the one hand it risks losing one of its healing factors, the work with the body experience; and on the other hand it becomes an indispensable therapeutic tool in the face of a situation where there is deep suffering due to bodily deprivation that threatens the deep and global identity of people.
